EBF - GDPR PRIVACY STATEMENT

The Humberside County Bowling Association EBF has the legal and moral duty to protect the data of their members, many point of GDPR already apply under current data protection laws. The GDPR became enforceable from 25th May 2018. It replaces the Data Protection Act 1998 and covers the storage and use of 'Personal Data'. Personal data is defined as any piece of personal information that can be used to identify an individual, either directly or indirectly.

This includes information such as an individual's:

- Name
- Telephone Number
- E-mail address
- Date of birth
- Health information
- Location data
- Online identifier e.g. IP addresses or cookie

Information regarding internal or external matches such as fixtures association matches, county or national matches. This is not a fully inclusive list as there may be additional matches or bowling tours.

Interns of sharing data with other members, contact details, name, email address, telephone number and address data are subject to members' consent. This should be agreed via the bowlers' consent form. Members should all so be asked to confirm via the consent form that any photos taken whiles attending bowls or other activities of the association may be used with in the association or for external promotion of the association.

No other sensitive information should be shared without separate agreement.

We align the GDPR policy to English Bowls Federation and Government Advice.

We will not share members information with third parties without their informed consent.

We will ensure that parents or official guardian accept receipt of information on behalf of children (aged under 18). In accordance with English Bowls Federation safeguarding policy.

We will delete members information should they leave the association.
